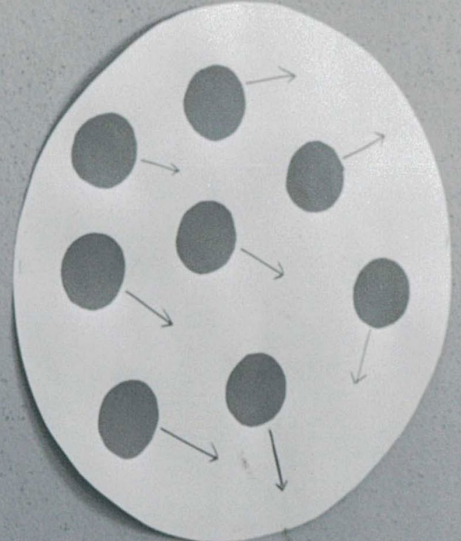
Molecules are always moving
